the more difficult to access Upper Sycan River canyon...



and the very easily accessed North Fork Sprague River.





Many sections of the Fremont Forest are still healthy and untouched by bark beetles.



Found here are some magnificent groves of old growth ponderosa and fir...



...and numerous wet meadows with spring wildflowers and aspen groves.



Coleman Rim is a rugged, still pristine, high elevation ridge with great views.
