The western hike starts at the Sandhill Crossing bridge, on the north river bank.



For the first mile, the river runs north to south and the hike follows cow trails along the grassy bank.



Soon, the riverside trail enters a narrow, rocky canyon, where the stream runs east to west.



For the last mile, the hike is through streamside meadows to the private land at Lee Thomas Meadow.



The eastern hike starts at the Lee Thomas Campground bridge, on the east river bank.



The hike follows cow trails along streamside meadows that are very lightly grazed...



...with showy wildflowers in spring and early summer.



After a little over a mile, the hike ends at the private land at Lee Thomas Crossing.
