



Road Map to Trailhead

Baldy Lake Trail

Wallowa-Whitman National Forest - Baker District

From paved Hwy 73, 3.9 miles north of Granite or 4.6 miles south from the North Fork John Day Campground, turn east onto gravel Road 7345. Follow this road east, past the turnoff for Road 720 at 2.1 miles, for 5.2 miles to a big switchback.

Park on this switchback to avoid the steep, rocky 4-wheel drive section of Road 400 past the switchback. Walk on Road 400 for 0.4 miles to a trail sign for Baldy Lake on the east side of the road.

NOTE: Road 7345 is rocky and rough throughout its length. The roadbed is made up of sharp, fist-sized rocks and is rutted in spots, requiring a high-clearance vehicle with strong tires. Plan on a slow trip, about an hour from Hwy 73 to the parking spot.
