



Road Map to Trailhead

East Eagle Creek Trail

Wallowa-Whitman National Forest - Pine District

On Forest Road 77, about 5.6 miles east of the Tamarack Campground, turn north on Road 7745 and drive 5.4 miles to the equestrian trailhead. Don't stop here, but drive 0.7 miles further to the hiking trailhead at the end of the road.

Take care driving through the ford of Little Kettle Creek 0.3 miles before the trailhead — the water can be high in early summer, but passable by normal clearance vehicles.

A self-issued Wilderness Permit is required at the trailhead.
