



Road Map to Trailhead

Granite Creek Trail

Umatilla National Forest

North Fork John Day District

From the town of Granite, drive 1.3 miles west on paved Road 24, to a junction where dirt Road 1035 branches to the right (north).

Follow Road 1035 along the north bank of Granite Creek for about 4.6 miles to a signed turnoff on a spur road (Road 010) to the left. Follow this spur road for about 0.2 miles to the prominent trailhead.

This trailhead is easily accessible by any passenger car. A Northwest Forest Pass is required to park at the trailhead.
