



**Road Map to Trailhead**  
**Sawtooth Ridge Trail**  
 Umatilla National Forest - Pomeroy District

From Hwy 12 in the town of Dayton, WA, turn south on 4th Street, then drive 23.2 miles up the North Fork Touchet River canyon, past the Bluewood Ski Area, to a road junction. This road is paved to the ski area and becomes Road 64 at the Forest boundary.

At the road junction, turn left (east) onto Road 46 and drive 3.7 miles to where dirt Road 420 branches to the right (south). Follow Road 420 (Burnt Flat Road) through a long clearing, then up a short steep incline, for 0.2 miles to the trailhead sign.

If your vehicle can't negotiate the steep incline, just park below it and walk the final 0.1 miles to the trailhead.
