

Photos of Temperance Creek Trail
Hells Canyon National Recreation Area

The Temperance Creek Trail descends from a forested rim (left center) to dark basalt viewpoints below it.



The unsigned trail starts east up the hill behind the parking area at the Warnock Corral Trailhead.



Reaching the rim, at 0.6 miles the trail forks right at a rock cairn, before descending through a fir forest.



Once below the trees, vistas are southeast across the Snake River canyon to the Seven Devils Range.



At 1.8 miles, the dark basalt viewpoints at hike's end come into view below the trail to the northeast.



Nearing the saddle at 2.4 miles, one can better see the two viewpoints and study their backslope ascents.



South from the viewpoints, one sees down Rush Creek to the Snake River and the Seven Devils Range.



To the north, one looks down Sand Creek into the Snake River and past Somers Point to the Idaho rim.
