Hart Mountain Antelope Refuge (USFWS)

The DeGarmo Canyon trailhead is a small flat at the western base of the Hart Mountain range.



The first 100 yards is a steep scramble over rocks through a narrow slot in the canyon.



The next half mile is an easy trail walk through colorful rock formations and rims...



...leading to a 35-foot waterfall cascading over a rock rim at the 0.7 mile point.



Past the waterfall is a steep, half-mile scramble 400' up through the rocks to reach the cattle drive trail.



Once on the cattle drive trail, it's an easy and scenic 2-mile walk into Upper DeGarmo Canyon.



In the upper canyon, the hillside trees are gradually replaced by low sage and open grasslands.



On the cattle drive trail back to the trailhead are sweeping views of the Warner Valley wetlands below.
