The Lambert Rocks trail is one of the only hiking routes from the rim to the Owyhee River, 1,000' below.



Trailhead parking is on a narrow peninsula of land between Bogus Creek and the Owyhee River canyon.



Below the trailhead, the route passes the historical cabins and stone corrals of the Bogus Ranch (private).



For the next mile and a half, the route follows an old wagon road through the Lambert Rocks lava field.



The road then fords Bogus Creek and hikers will need to get their feet wet here.



For the next 2 miles to the river, the wagon road skirts the edge of the lava field, through open grassland.



Look for interesting pressure-cracked lava ridges and domes in this section.



The wagon road then descends to the water and hikers find their reward in a shady lunch at riverside.
