

**Photos of Lynch's Rim Hike**

Lynch's Rim is an uplifted fault block range on the west side of the Warner Valley.



The hike starts at the Cleland Spring turnoff sign and continues on foot up Road 7105.



After 1.2 miles, the hike follows a faint jeep track to the rim, with views west to the Warner Mountains.



The first views upon reaching the rim are across the Warner Valley to Hart Mountain in the northeast.



The best hiking route south along the rim is behind the thick stands of mountain mahogany at rim's edge.



After about one-half mile, one meets an east-west fenceline with a stone anchor on the rim's edge.



South from this fence, one can walk along the rim's edge, with great views of Pelican Lake to the south...



...and back northeast across Crump Lake to the Hart Mountain range.
